**CARBON CHANGE OUT AT MAIN ST. VILLAGE FILTER BLDG.**

**PURCELLVILLE, Va. September 18<sup>th</sup>, 2015** — The Town of Purcellville will be changing out the carbon in the Main Street Village Filter Building at 220 McDaniel Drive on Thursday, October 1, 2015 from 8 AM to mid afternoon. A large truck will be gaining access to the site and will produce some noise during the actual transfer. A hose will be run from the hydrant across the roadway from the filter building. This is part of our annual regular filter maintenance at the Main Street Treatment Facility.

**The Town of Purcellville, Virginia**

Purcellville is an award-winning town of nearly 8,300 residents located in Loudoun County, approximately 40 miles west of Washington, DC.
