**PURCELLVILLE, Va. January 26, 2016** — the Town is pleased to announce that trash and recycling will be collected tomorrow, Wednesday, January 27, as normally scheduled. Every attempt will be made by the contractor to reach all streets. While we have been able to open all Town maintained streets, if you are in an area where the streets are privately maintained the trash contractor may be unable to make it to you. In these areas service will resume next week.

**NOTE:** There will be no special collections tomorrow. Also, please do not place refuse and recycling containers in the roadways. Your safety and the safety of our contractors is our top priority.

Purcellville is an award-winning town of nearly 8,300 residents located in Loudoun County, approximately 40 miles west of Washington, DC.
