## **WATER LINE REPAIRS TODAY NEAR HATCHER AVENUE**

**PURCELLVILLE, Va. Wednesday, April 20, 2016** — Town staff is on-site working to repair a water line near the Nature Park Well System facility on Hatcher Avenue. The Town would like to ask users to refrain from activities that utilize large amounts of water, such as watering lawns, etc. until the repairs have been completed. Users in this area may experience some discoloration of their water during this period. There are no public health concerns associated with this discoloration, simply aesthetics. The repairs are expected to be completed later this afternoon.

### **The Town of Purcellville, Virginia**
