**Water Service Outage for N. 21<sup>st</sup> Street  
Between Main Street and N. 23<sup>rd</sup> Street**

**PURCELLVILLE, Va. June 15, 2015** — The Town's contractor for the 21st and 23rd Streetscape Improvements: Phase II project will be working on the watermain on N. 21<sup>st</sup> Street during the overnight hours of Wednesday, June 17, 2015.

Performing the watermain work will require a water service outage to several businesses and residents along N. 21<sup>st</sup> Street, between Main Street and N. 23<sup>rd</sup> Street. The outage may occur anytime between 10:00 pm on Wednesday, June 17, 2015 to 10:00 am on Thursday, June 18, 2015.

Flyers will be placed on doors of anticipated locations where the water service outage is expected during this work. Residents in this area may experience temporary discoloration in the water which will clear up after running the water for a short period.

In the case of inclement weather this work may be postponed. Local residents are asked to be aware of work zones and to be alert for changes in traffic patterns in areas where work is being performed.
