## **TRAFFIC PATTERN CHANGES AROUND PURCELLVILLE GATEWAY SHOPPING CENTER – NOV. 12-14**

**PURCELLVILLE, Va. November 10, 2015** — The Town of Purcellville wants to alert citizens, business patrons, and visitors of traffic changes that will take place Thursday, November 12<sup>th</sup> through Saturday, November 14<sup>th</sup>. In anticipation of heavy traffic and congestion surrounding the opening of the Chick-fil-A in the Purcellville Gateway Shopping Center, Town staff have worked with representatives of the restaurant and shopping center to ensure a safe flow of traffic during this time.

From 6:00am-10:00pm Thursday-Saturday, all traffic entering the Purcellville Gateway Shopping Center **must** use the Main Street (Business 7) entrance. The entrance from Berlin Turnpike (Route 287) will be closed during this time. Law enforcement will be providing traffic control along Route 287 and Main Street. Upon entering from Main Street, traffic will be directed depending on the driver's intended destination.

Both exits will remain open during these traffic pattern changes.
