PURCELLVILLE, Va. November 16, 2015 — In the spirit of the Christmas season, the Purcellville Parks and Recreation Board wants you to light up your neighborhood! Hang your decorations and lights, and your house may be selected to be a part of the annual “Christmas Lights Trolley Tour.”

Dates and information to remember for the Christmas Lights Trolley Tours are below:

November 30th - Deadline to be considered for Christmas Lights Trolley Tours. The trolley route will be decided in early December, so have your lights up by the evening of November 30th to be considered. No application needed.

December 11th and 13th - Annual Christmas Lights Trolley Tours - the tours will leave from the parking lot in front of the Bush Tabernacle at 250 S. Nursery Ave. Tours take place on **Friday December 11th from 6:00PM – 9:00PM** with the last trolley leaving at 8:15PM and again on Sunday **December 13th from 5:00PM – 8:00PM** with the last trolley leaving at 7:15PM. Tickets for tours will be handed out on a first come first serve basis the night of each tour; tours last approximately 45 minutes. Join us for a ride through Purcellville to look at the beautiful display of lights!
