**INCLEMENT WEATHER POLICY FOR CURBSIDE
REFUSE & RECYCLING COLLECTION**

PURCELLVILLE, Va. January 11, 2016 — As we move into the winter weather season, the Town would like to take this opportunity to provide a reminder regarding potential weather-related impacts on the weekly refuse and recycling collection. Safety is the primary concern during inclement weather and adverse conditions. Collection will not take place on any roads or areas that are deemed unsafe by either the refuse and recycling contractor and/or the Town due to snow, ice or other weather-related conditions. Service to any affected areas will resume on the following Wednesday. If the inclement weather or adverse conditions affect the entire Town, collection service could be totally suspended until the following Wednesday.

During an inclement weather event, the latest information, updates and impacts to collection will be posted on the official Town website at www.purcellvilleva.gov under the “Resident Info” tab in the blue shield and then “Refuse and Recycling Services”.
