February 23, 2016** — The Town of Purcellville is pleased to announce that the Department of Motor Vehicles' (DMV) mobile customer service center, *DMV 2 Go*, will be available to provide full service on **Tuesday, March 22, 2016 from 9:00 AM to 4:00 PM in the parking lot of Fireman's Field/Bush Tabernacle at 250 South Nursery Avenue.**

The full service office provides all DMV transactions including applying for and renewing driver's licenses, ID cards, Virginia's Vital Records, and Virginia's veterans ID card. Road and knowledge tests are available, and applicants may get their pictures taken.
