**VOLLEYBALL FUNDRAISING TOURNAMENT BETWEEN
TOWN COUNCIL, TOWN STAFF, AND HIGH SCHOOL FACULTY**

PURCELLVILLE, VIRGINIA – March 7, 2016 –

On Friday, March 11, 2016, at 7:00 PM, Woodgrove High School will host a volleyball tournament between the Town of Purcellville's leadership and the faculty members of Loudoun Valley High School and Woodgrove High School. The idea was generated by Mayor Kwasi Fraser as a way to promote a sense of community and cooperation, friendly competition, and physical fitness as a lifestyle.

The Physical Education (PE) departments of both schools as well as the Student Council Association (SCA) will be supporting this effort, and an award will be given to the winning team. With a goal of developing this into an annual event, funds raised will be divided between the two high schools for use with PE efforts.

Current rosters include Mayor Fraser, members of the Town Council, staff from the Town's Management Team, and various PE and faculty members from Woodgrove and Loudoun Valley. It is guaranteed to be a fun event with some friendly competition. The public is welcome and encouraged to attend; a small donation will be requested from attendees in order to support PE departments at the high schools.
