J STREET DRAINAGE IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT SET TO BEGIN

PURCELLVILLE, Va. April 21, 2016 — Beginning the week of April 25, 2016, the Town's Contractor will begin work necessary for the construction of the J Street Drainage Improvements project. The project is located along J Street from S. 26th Street to just west of Town Hall. The work will occur between the hours of 8AM-5PM, Monday to Friday. During working hours, J Street from S. 26th Street to Town Hall will be closed to thru traffic and detour signage will be in place. Local residents are asked to be aware of work zones and to be alert for changes in traffic patterns in areas where work is being performed. Total construction time is anticipated to take approximately 2-3 months.

Notice-to-Proceed has been issued to the Town's contractor, TJT Corporation, for the project. The project will improve drainage along J Street by installing a storm sewer along the street. The design was completed in fall 2015 and the project was publicly solicited for bidding in winter 2015.
