J STREET ROAD CLOSURE

PURCELLVILLE, Va. June 24, 2016— On Friday, June 24, 2016, the Town's Contractor Stuart M. Perry will be paving J Street between Orchard Drive and School Street. To conduct the pavement repair work, the road will be closed during the hours of 9:00am and 3:00pm. Detour signs will be in place during paving operations. The work is only expected to last one day.

Local residents are asked to be aware of work zones, drive with caution, watch for turning or stopping vehicles including construction equipment, and to be alert for changes in traffic patterns in areas where the paving is being performed.
