21st Street Concrete Repairs

PURCELLVILLE, Va. June 28, 2016 — During the week of June 27, 2016, the Town's Contractor will be making repairs to damaged concrete curbs and sidewalks along 21st Street, between Main Street and the entrance to the Town's parking lot just north of O Street. The work is only expected to last one night.

Demolition work is scheduled to take place at night, and concrete will be poured during morning hours. Please be aware of work zones and be alert for changes in vehicular and pedestrian traffic patterns in areas where work is being performed. Some sections of sidewalk and some parking spots may be temporarily closed. However, all businesses will be open regular business hours, and parking is always available at the Town Parking Lots on West Main Street and North 23rd Street.
