The 15<sup>th</sup> Annual Christmas in Purcellville Parade will be held on Saturday, December 15, 2018 at noon. Businesses, organizations, clubs, individuals, and families are invited to join in the fun with a float, a decorated car or truck, or you and your friends in your favorite holiday-themed outfits (walkers are welcome). Please be sure to note the new parade route will start at Loudoun Valley High School on North Maple Avenue, turn right onto Main Street, then right onto 21<sup>st</sup> Street, ending at the Train Station with parent pick-up and float dismantling at the Cardinal Concrete Plant.

Christmas in Purcellville's Festivities and the 15<sup>th</sup> Annual Christmas Parade take place in the heart of historic downtown Purcellville.
