## **21<sup>ST</sup> AND 23<sup>RD</sup> STREETS MILLING AND PAVING**

**PURCELLVILLE, Va. November 5, 2018**—The Town of Purcellville’s contractor, Stuart M. Perry, will be performing milling and paving work on 21<sup>st</sup> and 23<sup>rd</sup> Streets. The paving work will begin on Tuesday, November 6, 2018 through Friday, November 9, 2018, weather permitting. To conduct the milling and paving operations, the contractor will be utilizing flagging operations and have alternating single lanes of traffic. Flagging and alternating single lanes of traffic will be occurring between 9:00am and 3:00pm.

Local residents are asked to be aware of work zones, drive through with caution, watch for turning or stopping vehicles, entering and exiting construction traffic, and to be alert for changes in traffic patterns in areas where the paving is being performed.
