PURCELLVILLE, Va. JUNE 22, 2018 — Due to scheduling conflicts, the Planning Commission Regular Meeting scheduled for Thursday, July 5, 2018 has been canceled.

The Planning Commission will hold their advertised Special Meeting/Work Session on Thursday, June 28, 2018 at 7:00 PM (revised and reissued [agenda](#) available online), and their first regular meeting in July is scheduled for Thursday, July 19, 2018 at 7:00 PM at Town Hall.

Today, Purcellville is the economic hub of western Loudoun County and a popular weekend destination for antiques, entertainment, farmer's markets, wineries, breweries, distilleries and restaurants.
