**TOWN HALL CLOSED TODAY
REFUSE AND RECYCLING COLLECTION
RESCHEDULED FOR SATURDAY, FEBRUARY 23, 2019**

PURCELLVILLE, Va. February 20, 2019 — With the continued winter weather system moving through the area with significant snow, sleet and ice expected, the Town Manager has closed the Town Hall and all Town administrative operations today.

In addition, the collection of refuse and recycling for this week has been **rescheduled to Saturday, February 23**. Please place your items curbside Friday evening.

Today, Purcellville is the economic hub of western Loudoun County and a popular weekend destination for antiques, entertainment, farmer's markets, wineries, breweries, distilleries and restaurants.
