WELL MAINTENANCE ACTIVITIES

PURCELLVILLE, Va. April 23, 2019 — Beginning on Tuesday, April 23rd, maintenance activities will be conducted at Town wells located along the South Fork Catoctin Creek near 320 North Hatcher Avenue. Please use caution when approaching the work area and be aware of work crews, stopped vehicles, and construction equipment. Note that a portion of the walking trail in the Suzanne Kane Nature Preserve near the work area has been closed for the duration of maintenance activities. The maintenance activities are expected to be complete by Wednesday, May 1st.
