PURCELLVILLE, Va. July 2, 2019 — Enjoy great food and drink at the Purcellville Wine and Food Festival on Saturday, July 13 in historic Dillon’s Woods at the Fireman’s Field Complex. Local wineries and vineyards will be sampling a wide array of varietals helping you taste and learn about each one. Bring your family and friends to enjoy the beautiful outdoors and all that this event has to offer.

This year’s festival has more than 25 vendors including 8 wineries, 10 food purveyors, 9 artisans, and 3 brewing companies. There will also be live music, face painting, and other activities.
