



A “**SMOKE TEST**” survey will assist our inspection crews in locating breaks and defects in our sewer system. The white/gray smoke you may see coming from the vent stacks on houses or holes in the ground is **NON-TOXIC, NON-STAINING, HAS NO ODOR AND CREATES NO FIRE HAZARD.**

*The smoke should not enter your home unless you have defective plumbing or dried up drain traps.*

It is advisable for the home owner to pour a gallon of water into each floor drain prior to our testing. If smoke enters your home, there is good reason to assume that dangerous sewer gases may also be entering your home or business. You should evacuate immediately and notify our inspectors. If you are not home and discover smoke when you return, please call the Public Works Maintenance Superintendent at 540-454-1559.

This schedule may change in the event of inclement weather or unforeseen circumstances.

**IMPORTANT! If there is any individual in your home and/or business who has respiratory problems and is immobile, please notify one of the parties above prior to testing.**
