The tours will be held Saturday, December 14 and Sunday, December 15 from 6 to 9 p.m. and will start at the Bush Tabernacle. Each 45-minute tour is free, but space is limited and tickets are required. Today, Purcellville is the economic hub of western Loudoun County and a popular weekend destination for antiquing, equestrian activities, farmer’s markets, wineries, breweries, distilleries and restaurants.
