WEEKLY CORONAVIRUS UPDATE 6.18.20**

PURCELLVILLE, Va., June 18, 2020 — Attached is the Town of Purcellville Weekly Coronavirus Update. Purcellville continues to operate under Phase Two guidelines under [Executive Order 65](#). Executive Order 65 allows for 50% capacity of indoor and outdoor dining at restaurants, 30% occupancy of indoor fitness facilities, reopening of pools for exercise (with restrictions), and public and private indoor gatherings of up to 50 individuals.

The Town of Purcellville would like to remind residents that drive-through COVID-19 Infection and Antibody testing is available, tomorrow, **Friday, June 19th, from 9 a.m. to 7 p.m.**, outside the former Rite Aid location (801 E. Main Street, Purcellville) on the corner of East Main Street and Ken Culbert Jr. Road. Tests will cost \$150, but those tested will receive a bill they can submit for potential insurance reimbursement. Aperiomics will bill Medicare for participants who have Medicare. Drivers should use caution in that area due to possible traffic delays.

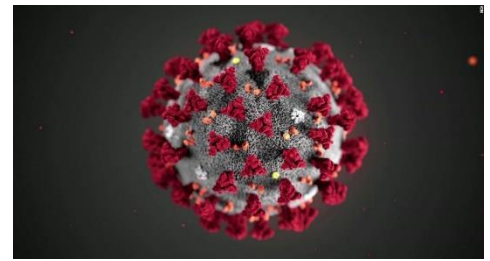

REMINDERS:

- Purcellville continues to operate under Phase Two guidelines under [Executive Order 65](#) which allows for 50% capacity of indoor & outdoor dining at restaurants, 30% occupancy of indoor fitness facilities, reopening of pools for exercise (with restrictions), and public and private indoor gatherings of up to 50 individuals.
