PURCELLVILLE, Va., June 27, 2022 — Enjoy great food and drink at the Purcellville Wine and Food Festival on Saturday, July 16 in the historic Dillon’s Woods at the Fireman’s Field Complex. Local wineries and vineyards will be sampling a wide array of varietals helping you taste and learn about each one. Bring your family and friends to enjoy the beautiful outdoors and all that this event has to offer.

This year’s festival has a variety of vendors including wineries, food purveyors, artisans, and brewing companies. There will also be live music, face painting, caricature drawing, corn hole, and other activities.

General admission tickets to the Purcellville Wine and Food Festival are \$5 (\$10 at the gate) and include entry to the festival and a souvenir glass. Wine tastings, glasses and bottles of wine will be sold by participating wineries. Once a stop along the W&OD rail line, which has been converted to a multi-use trail from Alexandria, VA to Purcellville, the Town has maintained its historic old-town feel through the restoration and maintenance of its many downtown structures, reflecting the Victorian architecture popular during the early 1900s. Today, Purcellville is the economic hub of western Loudoun County and a popular weekend destination for antiquing, equestrian activities, farmer’s markets, wineries, breweries, distilleries and restaurants.
