DEFINITIONS

Domestic Wastewater – The wastewater from residences and institutions, carrying body wastes (the water used to flush toilets, combined with the human waste and toilet paper that it flushes away). Also washing water/greywater from sinks, tubs, showers, dishwashers, food preparation wastes, and laundry wastes and other waste products of normal living. Liquid-carried wastes from stores and service establishments serving the immediate community, termed commercial wastes, are included in the domestic wastewater category if their characteristics are similar to household flows.

Process Wastewater – Any water that, during manufacturing or processing, comes into contact with or results from the production or use of any raw material, intermediate product, finished product, byproduct, or waste product, including wash water used in cleaning equipment, vehicles and etc.

Pretreatment – The treatment of wastewater by commercial or industrial facilities to remove harmful pollutants before being discharged to the town sanitary sewer system.
